Grace Academy Science Fair

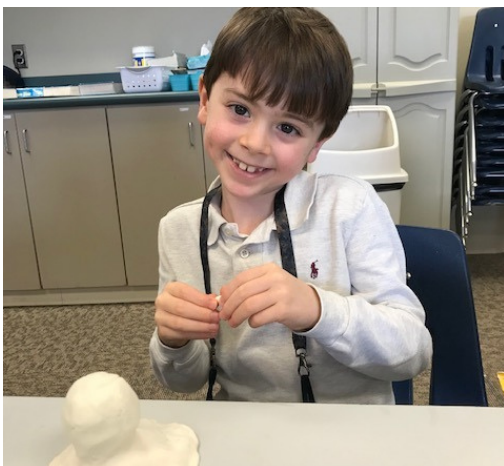
